Fear brings failure; faith brings success; it is just that simple. If you keep this in mind as you read the contents of this little book, you will find it a delightful spiritual adventure.

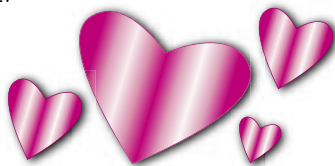

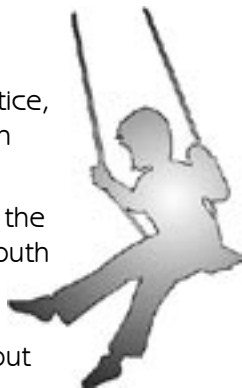
