
Affirm: To be kind, to be loving, to be helpful to all in my world is my choice today.

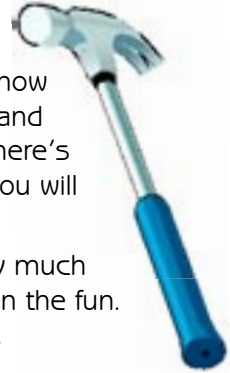
