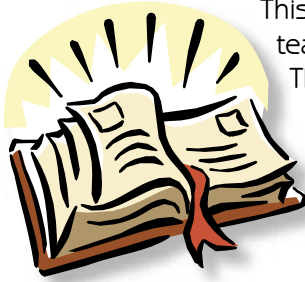

A DIFFERENT KIND OF SEMINAR AND CLASS!

One of the greatest deterrents to demonstrating our good is something we each reinforce every moment of every day – our own Self-Worth. **“Are you worth it?”** is the ultimate question we each consciously and subconsciously weigh-in on when evaluating our relationship to our desires. It is a question which has nothing to do with the past or the future – with who you were, or who you will become. The question is, do we see ourselves as “enough” now?
