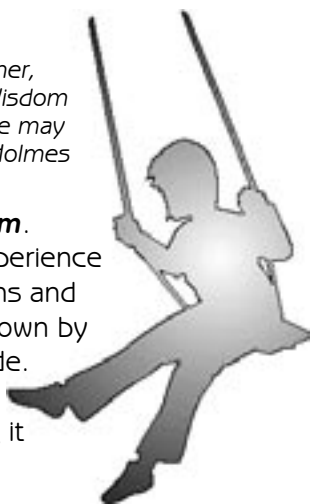
Youth Program
