The Mother Tongue for females is not the spoken languages across the globe, but rather the sister kinship, based on speaking the reality of a female's life experiences.

Ancient South Slavic grandmothers once walked to a single rhythm, and evoked White Birch Tree Councils, where their gossip was the language of the Mother Tongue. The word origin of gossip means, "language of the Goddess". South Slavic storied aprons are the first person stories of daughters, mothers and grandmothers, handed down through DNA into future generations. Often the Slavs embroidered apron pockets for old dolls, keys, and jewelry to be passed on to their daughters. What would be in your apron?
