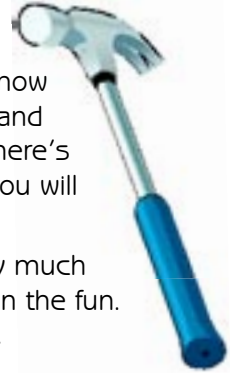

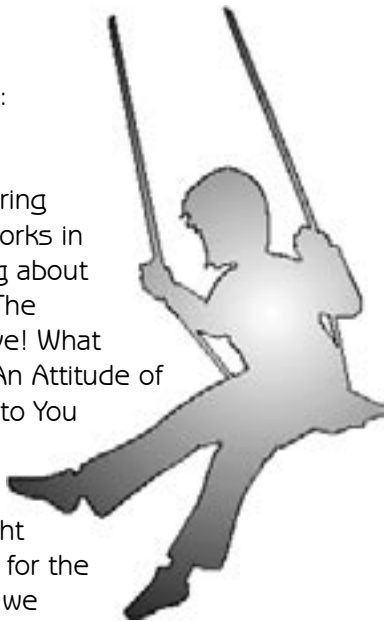
Youth Program
