## **Spiritual Growth Spurt – My First Summer Camp Experience**

RSI Summer Camp is not like any other camp. Here, the whole camp welcomed me as a brother. The best part of camp, to me, is the trust everyone shares in one another.

I view camp as two families. One family contains everyone at camp and it is filled with laughter and conversation. The other is the one with which we do workshops. Each youth gets assigned to a group of two or more advisors with about seven other youth.

I did my daily workshops with this “family”. The workshops helped us learn more about ourselves and the inner light within us. I learned to release the past and the resentment held inside; to trust others with the deep story of my life; and how to recognize the power I have within. This is where a lot of trust is held.

Camp is very different from our day-to-day lives, because not everyone knows the love, trust, and openness that is shared at camp. It is a place of unconditional love – a yearning to expand to the minds of others. It is where I had a spiritual growth spurt.

## **Summer Youth Camp – Malawi, Africa Project** by Matt Berthet

The theme for Summer Camp 2006 was “Shift Happens”. Our intention for this year was to grow to a minimum of 350 people and become more international. In the past, Canada’s participation had given us international status. This summer, we had 352 youth and advisors, including a father, Walter, and one of his fourteen adopted children, Jabu, from Malawi, Africa!

Walter told me he’d like to send some musicians from camp over to Malawi to play music in an effort to boost morale for the people there. We met with the Director of Youth Seminars, Rev. Keith Cox, to discuss the idea, and decided we would build schools there, as well. Walter estimated it would cost \$10,000 to build just one, but such a building could also serve as a community center for nearby villagers. During the next three days, we raised over \$17,000 in contributions from the youth, the advisors and RSI. With one man’s idea, we showed ourselves that with the right intentions, shift does happen. Our expectation is that by next summer we will have made Walter’s dream a reality.
